Morristown Utilities (MU) has a rich legacy in providing essential services in its role as the utility arm of the City of Morristown, TN since 1903. We provide electric, water and wastewater services to over 15,000 residents and businesses in Morristown. In 2005 MU enabled Morristown to become one of the first 7 cities in TN to provide state of the art fiber to the home (FTTH) broadband services including internet, video, and phone.

Appalachian Electric Cooperative (AEC) is a not-for-profit cooperative providing electricity to almost 50,000 members in parts of Jefferson, Grainger, Hamblen, Hawkins, and Sevier Counties in eastern Tennessee. Formed in 1940 to provide transformational electric services, AEC continues this tradition today by powering fiberoptic based broadband services with our partner, Trilight.

Sevier County Electric System (SCES) has been servicing the area since 1912. The service area of the System is composed of over 61,257 residential, commercial, and industrial customers in most of Sevier, and parts of Blount and Jefferson Counties including Sevierville, Pigeon Forge, Gatlinburg, Pittman Center, Townsend, and the Great Smoky Mountain National Park.
