Energy Demand Forecasting is an Al-driven, Built on a modernized Lakehouse architecture in Databricks, it ingests and harmonizes disparate data sources—historical usage, weather feeds, operational schedules and market indicators—into a single platform. Advanced machine-learning models then generate precise short- and long-term electricity and fuel consumption forecasts, empowering commercial and industrial clients to optimize procurement, reduce peak-load costs and drive sustainability.

Beyond forecasting, Databricks allows for financial and operational dashboards that unify P&L, revenue, cost and asset-performance metrics into intuitive, real-time views. We've also launched an "Al Call Logs" project to support broadband sales: call recordings are transcribed, analyzed for sentiment and categorized to surface upsell opportunities and refine sales tactics. Finally, our centralized Al document repository ingests unstructured files, applies NLP for semantic search and automated classification, and ensures that all teams can quickly find and reuse key knowledge assets.
